






Fellowship Meetings – October 2018

















Rotary Club of Dubai, led by President Hassan Al Rais and Board of Director, held the First Club Assembly in World Trade Club.

The following are the discussed topics:

- Review of 5 Avenue of Service;
 - 1. Club Service
 - 2. Vocational Service
 - 3. Community Service
 - 4. International Service
 - 5. New Generations Service
- Club Budget
- Projects Updates
- Rotary Activities
- DG Michel Jazzar Program for Official Club Visit
- Open Forum

In the part of Open Forum, Secretary General James Berry informed the Club about the Memorandum of Understanding that the Club has been in discussion with Rotary Club of Jumeirah and other Rotary Clubs in Dubai.

Under this Memorandum of Agreement;

The Board Noted that:

1. Members and/or officers of Rotary Club of Jumierah ("RCJ") have obtained a license (the "License") from Dubai Government Community Development Authority.

- 2. RCJ has informed Rotary Club of Dubai (the "Club") that the License is the only officially recognized license under which each Rotary Club in Dubai shall independently operate and has represented to the Club that the Club is required by higher authority to operate under the License and not otherwise.
- 3. The Club presently has no license to operate in Dubai.
- 4. Under Article 2.080 of the Rotary Code of Policies, every club is expected to comply with the laws of the country in which it exists and functions and, before taking action to do so, each Rotary Club is required to submit such action to the Board for review.
- 5. The Club has been in discussion with RCJ and others with regard to the terms under which each Rotary Club shall independently operate under the License and, in the course of such discussions, the attached Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") has been prepared for approval and signature by each party thereto.
- 6. The Board is satisfied that (as required by the said Article 2.080) such action (and any arrangements made relating to the organization and functioning of the Club within Dubai) do not contravene the Club's Constitution or associated documents as they relate to the practical administration and functioning of the Club.
- 7. The Board is satisfied that (as required by the said Article 2.080) it will continue to submit to the constitutional documents of Rotary international and to be and function as a member Rotary Club of Rotary International.
- 8. At the Club Assembly held on 22nd of October 2018, the Board duly informed the members of the Club about the above mentioned discussions concerning operation of the Club and other Rotary Clubs in Dubai under the License and the members present at the Club Assembly were in favour of such action being taken.

It was resolved as follows;

- 1. That the Club shall become party to the MOU
- 2. That the President or his nominee in writing shall be authorized to sign the MOU on behalf the Club;
- 3. However, this discussion has been carried forward subject for final agreement not later than 31st of December 2018.

Rotary Club of Dubai History


Formed in March 2002, by a group of Business Leaders who wanted to Embrace the Diversity of Dubai's growing population through friendship and service.

- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?



The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

SECOND: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

It is present in **3 CONTINENTS** and **9 COUNTRIES**:


Lebanon, Cyprus, Jordan, Sudan, Bahrain, UAE, Georgia, Armenia and Palestine.

In 1929, the East Mediterranean Provisional District (District 2452 today) was formed by RC Cairo (11-03-1929), RC Alexandria and RC of Beirut (02-02-1932).

- **In 1936**, Our District 2452 was called **District 83**
- In 1949, Our District 2452 was called **District 89**
- **In 1957**, Our District 2452 was called **District 195**
- **In 1977**, Our District 2452 was called **District 245**
- **In 1991,** Our District 2452 was called **District 2450**

Were included in the District in addition to the mentioned countries: Iraq and Syria.

In 2013, District 2452 is the new name of our District and is formed by: Armenia, Bahrain, Cyprus, Georgia, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, Sudan and UAE.




